

SCHOOLING/FUN SHOW RULES & INFORMATION

Flat classes in each division will be held in the outdoor ring immediately followed by jumping in the indoor.

1. Fairwinds Farm will not be responsible for any injury done to horse, rider, equipment or spectators, or any theft.
2. The judge's decision will be final.
3. The show committee reserves the right to combine, change, or cancel any classes.
4. Braiding is unnecessary. Informal attire acceptable but hard hats and safe footwear are required.
5. All fence heights are approximate.
6. Martingales are prohibited in all under saddle classes.
7. There will be no refunds for missed classes.
8. There will be an ENFORCED one minute call-up time for all classes.
9. All dogs must be on a leash and no alcoholic beverages allowed.
10. Food will be available on the premises.
11. Schooling will alternate between indoor and outdoor rings all day.

Order of Classes

Leadline – Open to riders 6 and under. May ride horses or ponies.

1. Leadline walk
2. Leadline advanced – may be asked to trot
3. Leadline off lead – walk with rider, may be asked to ride a pattern

Beginner Child 1 – For ages 4-8 in their first year of showing. May ride horses or ponies.

4. walk
5. walk – trot
6. walk/trot/canter
7. over fences – 12” x-rails.

Beginner Child 2 – For ages 9-12 in their first year of showing. May ride horses or ponies.

8. walk
9. walk – trot
10. walk – trot – canter
11. over fences – 18” x-rails.

Beginner Child 3 – For ages 13-17 in their first or second year of showing.

12. walk/trot
13. walk/trot/canter
14. over fences – 2’0” x-rails

Beginner Adult – For ages 18-29 in their first or second year of showing.

15. walk/trot
16. walk/trot/canter
17. over fences – 18” straight rails

Thirtysomething – open to ages 30 and over in their first or second year of showing.

18. walk – trot
19. walk – trot – canter
20. over fences – 18” straight rails

Beginner Pony – 1st or 2nd year of showing

21. walk – trot
22. walk – trot – canter
23. over fences – 2’0” x-rails.

Beginner Horse – 1st or 2nd year of showing

24. walk – trot
25. walk – trot – canter
26. over fences – 2’0” straight rails

Lesson Horse/Pony – School Mounts only!

27. walk/trot
28. walk/trot/canter
29. over fences – 2’0” straight rails

Fun Classes

Ribbons and Prizes awarded

May ride English or Western, horses or ponies.

30. Trainer/Parent Leadline – Kids up to 13 years old lead your parent or trainer!

31. Break And Out – Command class

32. Dollar Bareback Winner keeps the dollars!

33. Keyhole Race – race to the end of the ring and back while staying inside the “keyhole.”

34. Egg & spoon – carry the egg to the end of the ring and back while mounted

35. Sack race – ride down, jump into your sack and hop back leading your horse.

36. Obstacle course – judged on ability to maneuver obstacles.

37. Pairs Class – walk, trot/jog, canter/lope as a pair!

38. Pole Bending – ride through the serpentine of poles and back. Best time wins!

39. Crop Relay – Race through the poles and hand off the crop for a partner to race back. Best time wins!
