## Jumper Show Classes

1. Warm up (no awards given)
2. Knock Down & Out - Ponies: 2'3", increasing 3" each time
3. Knock Down & Out - Horses: 2'6", increasing 3" each time
4. Speed Round - Ponies: Fences 2'3". Four seconds added for each knock down
5. Speed Round - Horses: 2'6", same as #4
6. Power and Speed - Ponies: 2'3", First round, no time applied. If pony goes clean, they re-enter for a timed round at 2'6"
7. Power and Speed - Horses: Fences 2'6". First round, no time applied. If horse goes clean, they re-enter for a timed round at 2'9"
8. Junior Jumpers: Riders under 18, horses and ponies. Fences 2'6" Timed round
9. Senior Jumpers: 18 & over, 2'9", timed round
10. Gambler's Choice - Ponies: Fences 2'3" - 3' Each fence has a point value, 60 seconds in the ring to accumulate the most points. Pick your course. Winner takes 1/2 of the class entry fees
11. Gambler's Choice - Horses: Fences 2'6" - 3'3". Same as # 10
12. Team Jumping: Team of 3, one to follow the other at a safe distance. Last jump to be jumped abreast

All fences are optional.

You will follow a trail marked with poems at your preferred pace, picking up candy at each checkpoint.
