Pee-Wee Rider (all ages)

1. walk
2. walk/trot (trot individually)
3. walk/trot pole (may be on leadline)

Beginner Rider

4. walk
5. walk/trot
6. Low x-rails (trot)

Beginner + Rider

7. Walk/trot
8. Walk/trot/canter (canter individually)
9. 18" x-rails (may trot or canter)

Twenty & Up –for riders 20 & over

10. Walk/trot
11. walk/trot/canter
12. over fences – 18" straight rails

Intermediate Rider

13. walk/trot
14. walk/trot/canter
15. over fences – 18" - 2' straight rails

Advanced Rider

16. walk/trot
17. walk/trot/canter
18. over fences – 2'3" straight rails

19. Costume Class
20. Pairs Class
21. Egg & Spoon
22. Obstacle Course

**STUDENT SHOW
RULES & INFORMATION**

The purpose of the student show is friendly competition, learning "the ropes" of showing, and having fun! List your horse preference and division in advance on the sign up sheet in the barn. The following will help you get started:

1. Please arrive no earlier than 45 minutes before start of show if you are in the first division. Your horse will be in for you, but you must groom and tack up.
2. Parents! Please come to the entry booth inside the ring and sign up your child when you arrive. You will pick up a number for them and make payment at that time.
3. A division consists of three classes: (see prize list.) Each class costs \$12 to enter. So a division is \$36 Each **division** takes approximately ½ hr. to complete, depending on the judge. Your jumping class will take place immediately following your flat classes. So when your division is finished, you can go home or stay for the fun classes!
4. **ATTIRE:** Does not need to be formal, but as well-groomed as possible:
 - A dark jacket if you have one
 - White or light colored shirt buttoned to the top
 - Hairnet or braids for long hair
 - Jodphurs, beeches, or stretch pants
 - Riding boots or some other type of boot or shoe with a hard sole and heel.
 - Riding helmet!

DURING THE SHOW

NO SCHOOLING is allowed on horses, except in special cases permitted by the show committee.
Riders must enter the proper division for their ability.
No cross entering is allowed, i.e, if you are entered in the beginner division, you can't enter classes in another division.
Pay attention and be prepared to hand over your horse immediately to the rider in the next division.
